- Play for enjoyment and become part of the rugby family.
- Accept the referee's decision and let your captain or coach ask any relevant questions.
- Play with control. Do not lose your temper.
- Always do your best and be committed to the game, your team and your club.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good play by your team or the opposition.
- Respect your teammates and your opponents. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Players will not exhibit obnoxious, impolite or antisocial behavior.
- Rugby is a team sport. Make sure you co-operate with your coach, teammates, and referees.
- Always remember that you owe a duty of care to your opponents. Tackle hard but fairly, do not intend to hurt your opponent.
- Winning and losing is part of sport: Win with humility – lose with dignity. Always shake hands with your opponent after the game.
- Remember that you have more in common with your opponent than 90% of your peers at school.

### Code of Conduct for Parents and Supporters

- Remember, young people play rugby for their enjoyment, not only yours.
- Encourage your player to always to play by the Laws of the Game.
- Teach young players that an honest endeavor is as important as winning, so that the result of each game is accepted without disappointment. Do not place emphasis on winning at all costs.
- Help young players work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
- Set a good example by applauding good play on both sides. Never ridicule, humiliate or shout at players for making a mistake or losing a match.
- Do not publicly question the referee's decision and never their honesty. Support all efforts to remove verbal & physical abuse from rugby. As a spectator do not use profane language or harass referees, coaches or players.
- Recognize the value and importance of volunteer referees and coaches and teach children to do likewise.
- If you disagree with an official, coach or administrator, raise the issue through appropriate channels rather than question in a public forum. Remember that we all volunteer our time for your child's involvement.
- Alcohol and drugs are forbidden at all matches, and all supporters must respect any ground rules in effect at any particular match.
- You are not allowed inside the playing enclosure during a match.
